What is different about the enrollment process:


 The new OPT <u>contract</u> (LEET0047-08) with an effective date of January 1, 2019 available on the ESC website and through Quote Plus https://dealer.cat.com/en/ps/esc-epp/esc/truck/overhaul-protection.html



- Effective 2019 Registration Contract (excludes Colombia and Venezuela)
- When the oil cooler is replaced during the overhaul, the complete oil cooler assembly, gaskets and seals are covered
- If the oil cooler is inspected and reused, the housing is no longer covered

What is the same about the enrollment process:

- The OPT inspection worksheet (LEHT0117-06) has not changed
- Under inspected components, the entire oil cooler is referenced as the oil cooler housing
- Example from the OPT inspection worksheet:



 The 2018 contract must continue to be used for overhauls to qualify for 2018 pricing available through 31 January 2019
